

Neurovascular Product Manager

Position Overview:

The Neurovascular Product Manager reporting to the Chief Product Officer (CPO) is responsible for the ultimate success of the Circle neurovascular product portfolio. The product manager develops and owns the product roadmap shepherding cross functional work to assure alignment with external stakeholder (patients, providers, key opinion leaders and regulators) needs. The position provides an opportunity to participate in building a novel Neurovascular business focused on applying health technology including artificial intelligence to support health care provider neurovascular decision making.

The position is responsible for the execution of the vision and accomplishment of business goals and will manage the process to changing product demands while keeping the features, function, workflows and the roadmap on track. The position has a unique, strategic and cross-functional leadership role working collaboratively with a dynamic team of professionals, academic key opinion leaders and the Chief Product Officer. This is a senior position that supports and participates at a level that influences important decisions to drive long-term success.

General Responsibilities:

The following duties provide a representative summary of the position's primary duties and responsibilities. Additional duties may be required as the Product Manager is the internal product champion who will assure overall team success.

- Ensuring integration of market and customer needs into the product strategy and roadmap.
- Collaborating with the cross-product teams to leverage technologies for mutual synergy.
- Releasing content/scoping and detailed documentation of feature and performance requirements aligned with the product requirement specifications.
- Assuring platform integration with OEM requirements as necessary.
- Initiating and leading the successful introduction and execution of new product initiatives and ensuring all relevant elements of the solution are delivered to meet requirements.
- Maintaining and documenting roadmap progression, release content and timing.
- As the product expert, working in concert with the marketing and sales teams to define, demonstrate and position our solutions to maximize revenues.
- Working with Regulatory to establish and extend appropriate policies and processes; ensuring processes are FDA, CE Mark, ISO and regulatory compliant.
- Working with external partners, End Users and all internal teams to ensure that solutions meet customer expectations on an ongoing basis
- Coordinating activities across the various functions of the company to ensure that all initiatives are strategically aligned.
- Managing the release process and sign-off process ensuring all applicable release deliverables have been fulfilled (regulatory, QA, user guides, documentation, technical and feature requirements).
- Reviewing and approval of Statements of Work (SOW's), specifications and project plans from Products perspective.
- Separately and in conjunction with Chief Design Officer and Chief Product Officer, assess new product and technology opportunities to add to Circle's portfolio
- Representing Circle to the industry as an expert in the field.

Required Skills/Experience:

- Detailed knowledge in the field of neurovascular imaging, workflow, software and market requirements
- Leadership skills required to work collaboratively across internal functions and key advisors to drive alignment, decision making and successful execution
- Attention to detail with an ability to think strategically
- Ability to succeed with rapid development environments and tools that are required in a health technology company
- Ability to communicate with engineers on technical topics while connecting their work to the ultimate vision and strategy
- The flexibility to operate in an embedded start-up; i.e. willingness to pivot and do what is required to accomplish success
- Travel expected less than 15% for attendance to key stroke congresses, field visits and team meetings
